There are several ways that Information & Referral services from Disability Network Mid-Michigan (DNMM) can be helpful for people.

Any Questions About Disability

Whether it's your rights, the law, accessibility, support groups, community resources, or facts about disabilities, DNMM has the answers.

Basic Needs

DNMM Information & Referral (I&R) specialists will help you access community resources for anything, including utility shut-off notices, food pantries, housing assistance and so much more.



SSI/SSDI

Anyone needing to apply for SSI/SSDI can contact DNMM for help with applications. Whether you are just starting the process or are seeking assistance for the best direction on filing an appeal, DNMM will work with you at any stage in the process.

Medicare/Medicaid

A certified MMAP (Medicare/Medicaid Assistance Program) counselor is located at DNMM to help with Medicare Part D, low-income subsidy, or any of your Medicare/Medicaid needs.

DHS Applications

Home Help services, Bridge Cards, cash assistance, and more—we will help you determine what you are eligible to apply for and help you fill out and submit applications.

Housing

Whether you're looking for housing or looking for help staying in your home, DNMM can help find resources for affordable and accessible housing, ramps, housing vouchers and payment assistance.



Peer Support & Mentoring

Sometimes someone with a disability wants to talk to someone else with a disability about obstacles in their life or in their community. We have a network of individuals dedicated to helping people overcome barriers. We also offer peer groups that meet daily for a variety of activities.

Assistive Technology
